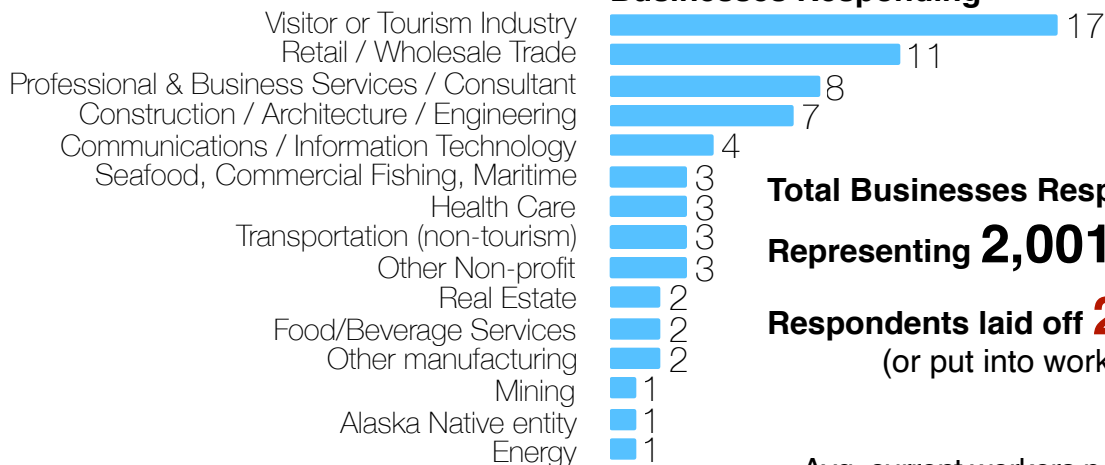




Southeast Alaska COVID-19 Business Impacts Survey: Juneau

Southeast Alaska business leaders were asked how COVID-19 is impacting their businesses. Surveying took place between March 20th and 25th. Responding Juneau employers have already laid off 12% their total workforce due to the COVID-19 virus, with an average of 4 layoffs per organization. Nearly one-third of Juneau businesses expect to cut more staff shortly. One-third of respondents risk closing permanently.

Businesses Responding



Total Businesses Responding = 69

Representing 2,001 current JNU workers

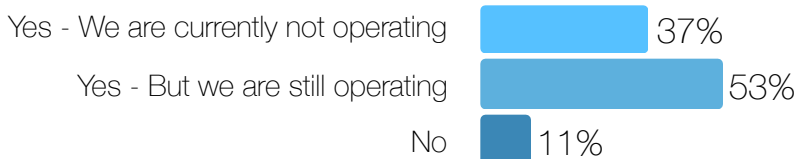
Respondents laid off 276 staff already
(or put into workers into unpaid status)

Avg. current workers per org. = **29** (37 in peak)

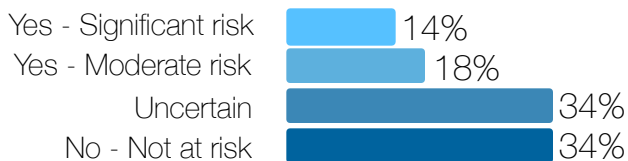
Avg. workers laid off so far per business = **-4**

Maybe = 33%

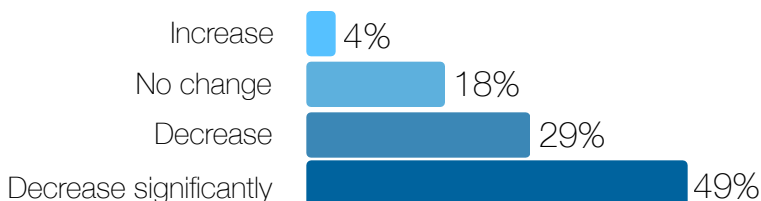
Have you experienced any disruption in business due to COVID-19?



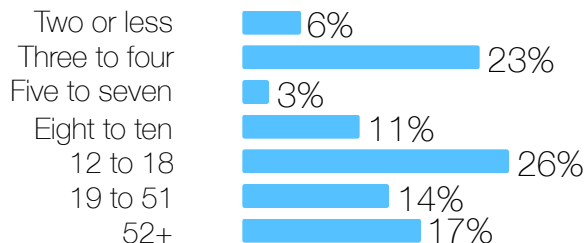
Is your business at risk of closing permanently because of impact caused by COVID-19?
