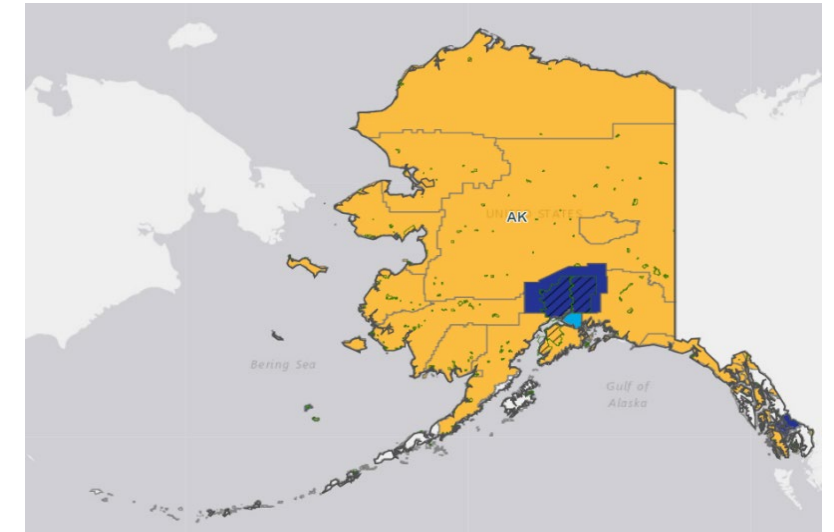

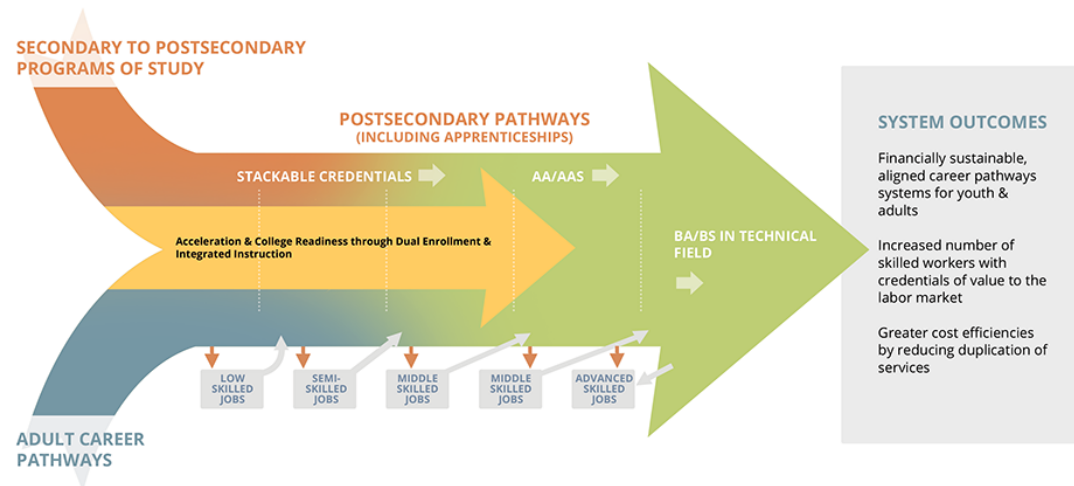
# OUR IMPACT

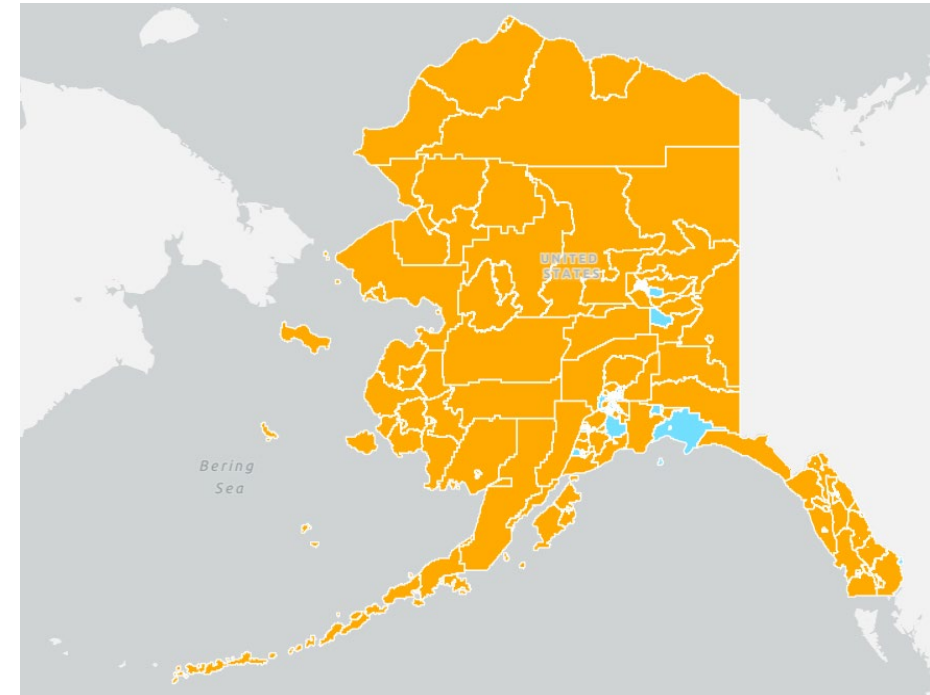


Figure 1: EPA IRA Disadvantaged Communities
