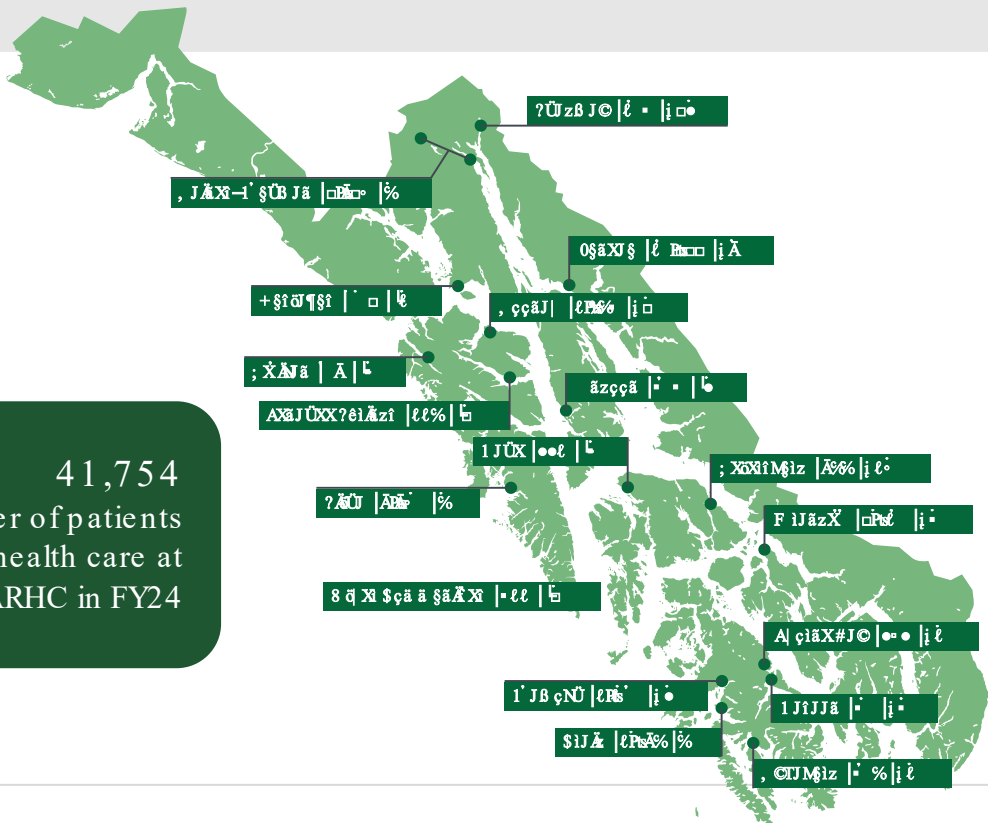

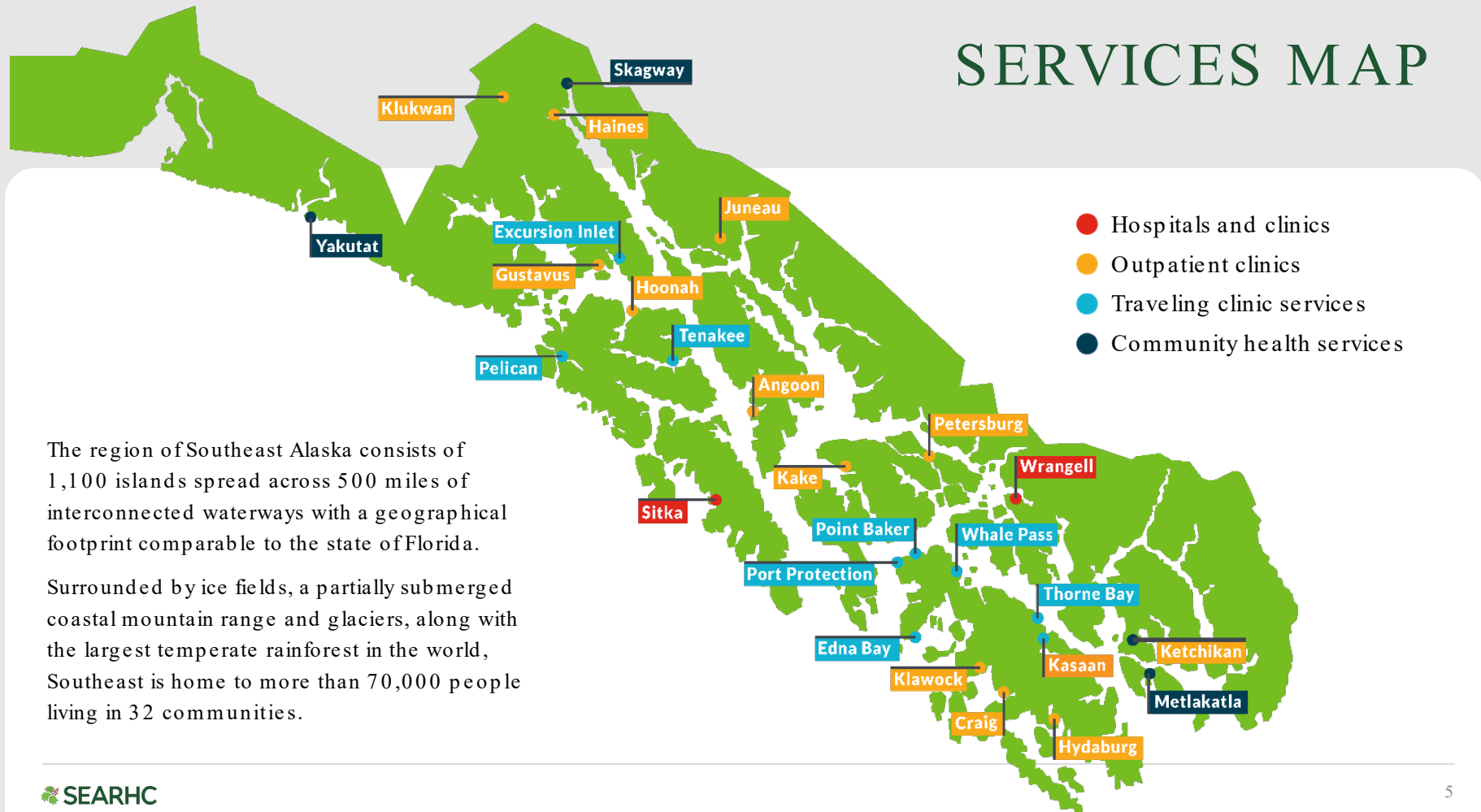

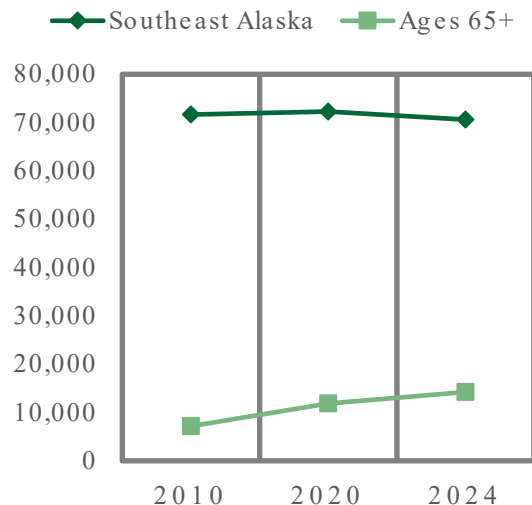

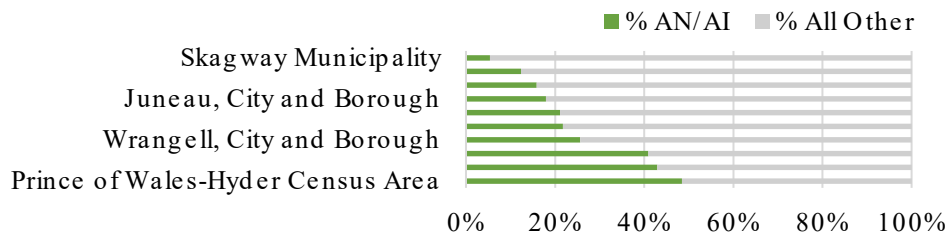

POPULATION TRENDS

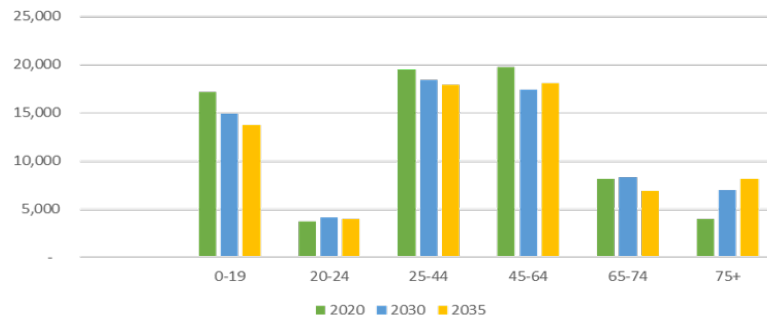

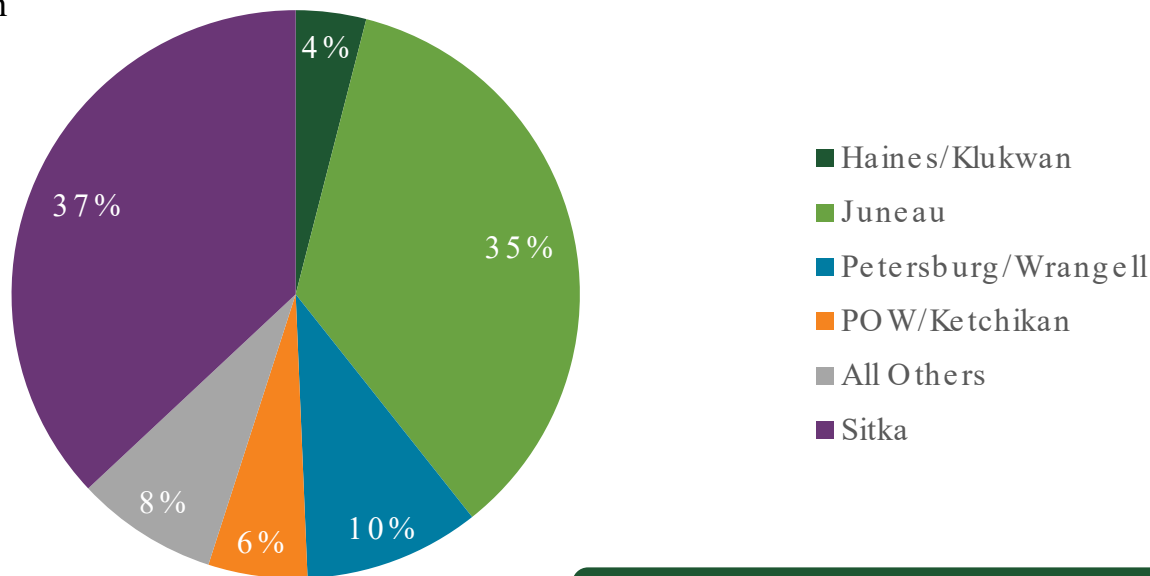

Major Employer

SEARHC is the largest private-sector employer in Southeast Alaska.*



Major Employer

If SEARHC were classified as its own sector, it would rank as the fourth-largest industry in the region.



Regional Wages

SEARHC directly contributes 8% of all wages in Southeast Alaska.

*SEARHC ranks just behind the State of Alaska, Federal Government and City & Borough of Juneau in total employment

ECONOMIC IMPACTS

Impact of SEARHC's payroll multiplied across the region:

\$182M ➡ \$273M

For every dollar spent on wages, another 50 cents is generated in other business & industries

Impact of SEARHC Jobs multiplied across the region:

1,650 ➡ 2,475

For every job in healthcare, another 0.5 job is generated in other business and industries

Impact of SEARHC Operations dollars multiplied across the region:

\$342M ➡ \$429M

For every dollar in Operational expenses, another 25 cents is generated in the regional economy
