





Total Economic Impact Open-Ended Summary

In 2024, Southeast Alaska Sustainability Strategy projects delivered broad economic impacts across the region. They created jobs for tribal citizens, youth, carvers, biologists, and educators—especially in rural lowemployment communities like Angoon and Kake—while strengthening local economies. Investments supported cultural preservation, tourism, fisheries, and food sovereignty. Environmental efforts restored salmon habitat, improved human-bear coexistence, and expanded biomass infrastructure. Capacity-building included youth training and tribal workforce development, laying the groundwork for lasting economic growth. Projects also leveraged federal and philanthropic grants and showed how targeted funding drives resilient, community-led development.
